

**A RESOLUTION OF THE PORT OF PALM BEACH DISTRICT, FLORIDA,  
BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS AUTHORIZING THE PORT OF PALM BEACH TO ENTER  
INTO AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH SOLID WASTE AUTHORITY FOR  
HURRICANE-RELATED DEBRIS REMOVAL, REDUCTION AND DISPOSAL**

**WHEREAS**, during the 2004 and 2005 hurricane seasons, Palm Beach County experienced extensive damage as a result of name storms making land fall; and

**WHEREAS**, the Port of Palm Beach suffered loss of power and damage to its property, buildings and infrastructures as a result of the hurricanes; and


**WHEREAS**, the Port of Palm Beach District does not have the capacity for hauling, reduction and disposal of debris resulting from any named category hurricane; and


**WHEREAS**, the Port of Palm Beach District desires to enter into an Interlocal Agreement with the Solid Waste Authority to expedite the removal, reduction and disposal of any storm debris following the passage of a hurricane to insure there is no danger to public life, health and safety as a result of a declared disaster;


**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Port of Palm Beach District Board of Commissioners in the interest of public life, health and safety authorizes the Port of Palm Beach District to enter into an Interlocal Agreement with the Solid Waste Authority for the removal, reduction and disposal of storm debris following the passage of any hurricane that includes Palm Beach County as a declared disaster area and payment to the Solid Waste Authority of any portion of the services not reimbursed by FEMA and the State of Florida.


